Dear Registered Crab Receiver:

This is a reminder that ***your current RCR permit expires June 30, 2009***. The enclosed form must be completed, signed, and returned to our office for processing; you may not commence fishing or processing activities for the 2009/2010 crab fishing year until you have received your new permit. Please allow at least ten working days for processing of your application.

Please note that we cannot issue any Crab Rationalization (CR) crab permits, including a renewal of an existing RCR permit, until you have submitted any required Economic Data Reports (EDRs) and paid all crab cost recovery fee liabilities. If you are subject to either requirement, but have not yet fulfilled it, we urge you to do so as soon as possible.
