Confiscation <b>or seized</b> .	63
Deadloss (crab only).	79

<b>R</b> etained for future sale.	87
Tagged <b>IFQ</b> Fish (Exempt from <b>debit</b> ).	64
<b>Whole fish/bait, not sold.</b> Used as bait onboard vessel.	92
<b>Whole fish/bait, sold.</b>	61
<b>Whole fish/discard at sea.</b> Whole groundfish and prohibited species discarded by catcher vessels, catcher/processors, motherships, or tenders. <b>DO NOT RECORD ON PTR.</b>	98
<b>Whole fish/discard, damaged.</b> Whole fish damaged by observer's sampling procedures.	93
<b>Whole fish/discard, decomposed.</b> Decomposed or previously discarded fish.	89
<b>Whole fish/discard, infested.</b> Flea-infested fish, parasite-infested fish.	88
<b>Whole fish/discard, onshore.</b> Discard after delivery and before processing by shoreside processors, stationary floating processors, and buying stations and in-plant discard of whole groundfish and prohibited species during processing. <b>DO NOT RECORD ON PTR.</b>	99
<b>Whole fish/donated prohibited species.</b> Number of Pacific salmon or Pacific halibut, otherwise required to be discarded, that is donated to charity under a NMFS-authorized program.	86
<b>Whole fish/fish meal.</b> Whole fish destined for meal (includes offsite production.) <b>DO NOT RECORD ON PTR</b>	41
<b>Whole fish/personal use, consumption.</b> Fish or fish products eaten on board or taken off the vessel for personal use. Not sold or utilized as bait.	95
<b>Whole fish/sold, for human consumption.</b>	60

**NOTE:** When using whole fish codes, record round weights *rather than product weights, even if the whole fish is not used.*

<sup>1</sup>**Disposition code: The intended use or disposal of the fish or shellfish.**
